Lakselv is often forgotten and seldom are mentioned in the same line as the Alta. Fact is that the Lakselv, just east of Alta in 2011 probably yielded more salmon above 20 kgs than the Alta, as all top-ten salmon were clearly above 20 kgs. This package is for two rods on all four public zones, and includes introductory guiding as well as accommodation in the charming but sparsely equipped guard's cabin on the river. Stop Press Lot: River Tay Islamouth Beat, five rods in three days 5 – 7 July

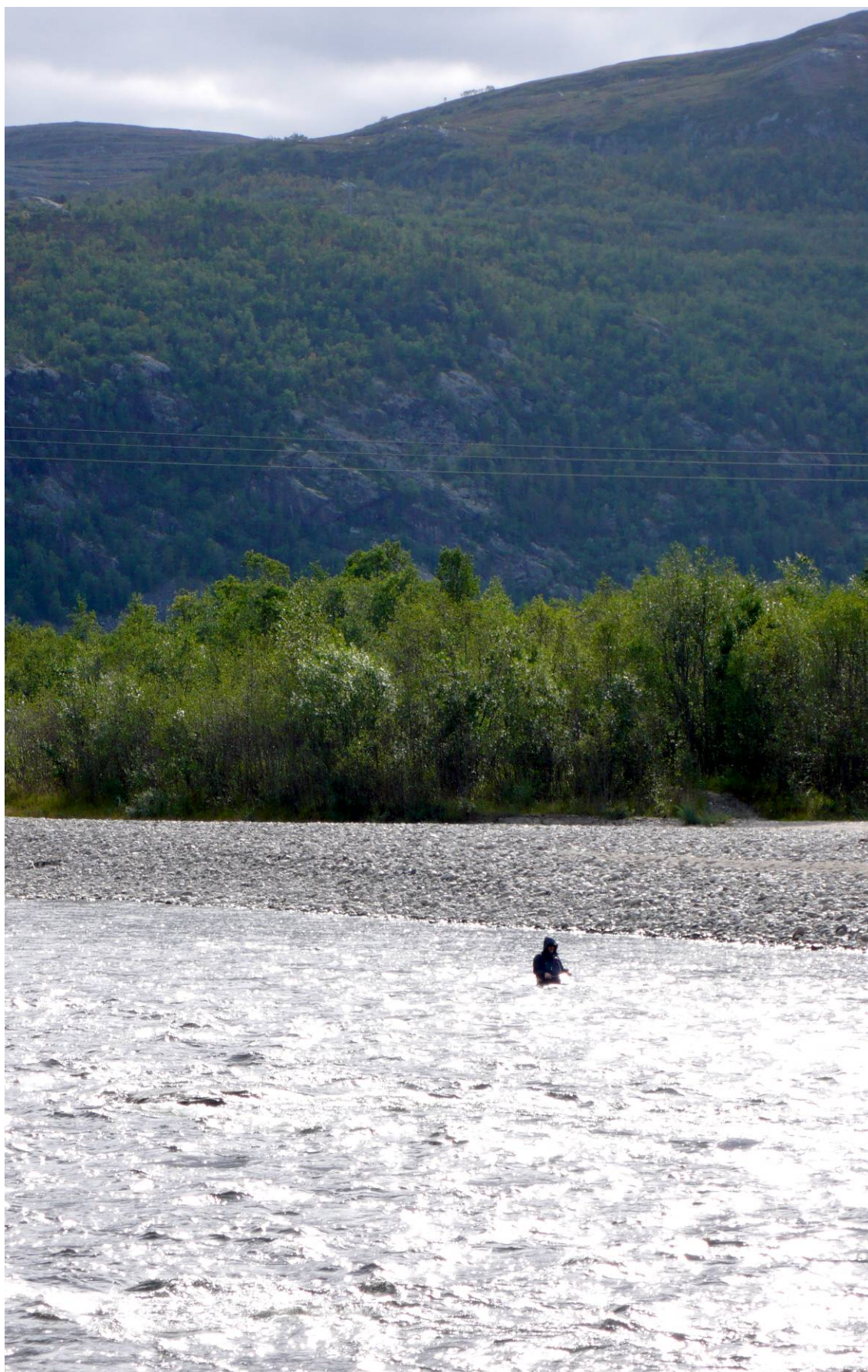
